Important Commercial Provider Manual update

We've updated our Commercial Provider Manual with new information about interpreter services for Oregon members receiving care from contracted providers. The update includes important details about medical interpreter services available to members.

Interpreter services for Oregon Commercial & Exchange members

Starting June 1, 2026, Moda Health will offer free interpreter services for eligible Oregon Commercial and Exchange members, at no cost. These services can help members communicate more easily with their care team and remove language barriers during care visits.

Interpreter services are available by phone, video or in person through Passport to Languages, an Oregon-based company that supports more than 160 languages and dialects.

How to request interpreter services

1. Check if an Oregon Commercial or Exchange member needs an interpreter
2. Log in to Benefit Tracker using your current account
3. Search for the member and select Medical Benefits
4. Complete and submit the form with:
 - Appointment date, time and length
 - Language needed
 - Interpreter method: In-person, phone or video
 - Preferred interpreter gender, if requested
 - Member phone number
5. Please submit your requests at least two business days before the appointment

To cancel a request, including within 24 hours of the appointment, call Passport to Languages directly at **800-297-2707**.

Interpreter services are only available for eligible Oregon Commercial and Exchange members with active Moda Health coverage at the time of service. Passport to Languages cannot check member eligibility. For eligibility questions, please call Moda Health Customer Service at **888-217-2363**.

Getting ready for the BY2025 initial validation audit

Each year, Moda Health takes part in HHS-operated Risk Adjustment Data Validation (HHS-RADV) audit. The audit is managed by CMS to help make sure diagnosis information submitted to the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) is complete and accurate.

Starting June 2026, Moda Health will request medical records for hospital outpatient and professional medical services during benefit year (BY) 2025.

Examples of acceptable records include:

- Progress, procedure and consultation notes
- History and physical notes
- Discharge summaries
- Operative and post-operative reports
- Emergency Room and anesthesia records
- Active problem lists included in encounter notes

CMS will choose a random sample of Moda Health members enrolled in ACA-compliant individual and small group plans, both on and off the Exchange for this audit. Providers who care for Moda Health members are required to participate and respond to medical requests in a timely manner.

IVA timelines are limited, which is why we ask that records be submitted as soon as possible after you receive a request. The request letter will include audit details and instructions for submitting documentation.

Maternity code changes are coming in 2027

New maternity coding changes will take effect for dates of service on or after Jan. 1, 2027. As a reminder, maternity coding for services provided in 2026 is not changing.

Moda Health is currently reviewing the AMA's new codes and guidance as we prepare updates to our Maternity Care reimbursement policy (RPM020). This work includes reviewing information from the June 2, 2026, AMA webinar (CPT 2027 Maternity Code Changes Explained), working with our editing vendors and completing internal planning and system updates.

We expect to publish the updated policy by the end of August 2026, or sooner if possible.

We understand that OB, midwife, and family practice offices may have questions about how these changes could affect billing requirements and related policies. We will share more information as soon as it becomes available.

The new coding guidance will apply only to services provided on or after Jan. 1, 2027.

Prevent delays: Only enter active other payer details

To prevent delays, only enter other payer information if the member had active insurance coverage on the date of service listed on the claim.

Entering inactive or incorrect coverage information may trigger a coordination of benefits (COB) request, which will delay claim processing.

Complete these highlighted fields only when the member has other active insurance coverage.

Handling higher allowed amounts for secondary claims

Moda Health COB coordinates to the higher allowed. If Moda's allowed amount is higher than the primary payer's allowed amount, benefits will be allowed up to our higher allowed amount.

Corrections are not required when:

- The services and primary EOBs are consistent, and
- The Primary EOB information has not changed
