What is the overall <u>deductible</u> ?	For <u>network providers</u> \$5,500 individual / \$11,000 family; for <u>out-of-network providers</u> \$11,000 individual / \$22,000 family.	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. In-network <u>preventive care</u> , primary care, <u>specialist</u> , <u>urgent care</u> , virtual care visits, office visits for outpatient behavioral health, outpatient <u>rehabilitation services</u> and <u>habilitation services</u> , and children's vision care as well as most in and out of network prescription medications are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> .	This <u>plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>deductible</u> amount. But a <u>copayment</u> or <u>coinsurance</u> may apply. For example, this <u>plan</u> covers certain <u>preventive services</u> without <u>cost sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . For <u>network providers</u> \$9,200 individual / \$18,400 family; for <u>out-of-network providers</u> \$18,400 individual / \$36,800 family.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <u>plan</u> , they have to meet their own <u>out-of-pocket limits</u> until the overall family <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> has been met.
What is not included in the <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> ?	Premiums, balance-billing charges, expenses incurred due to brand substitution and health care this plan doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>out-of-pocket</u> <u>limit</u> .

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.
